



AA in the Woods group adds an extra excursion for August 13. One half hour after the conclusion of the Columbia River Roundup we meet in the parking lot near Chiles Center at the University of Portland. We will carpool to the top of Larch Mountain near Corbett, Oregon. There will be an easy 1 mile loop walk to Sherrard Point with a Panoramic view of the Columbia River 4000 ft below and the major Cascade Volcanos. There will be an open AA meeting at the picnic area. Afterwards for those that wish, we will hike the Larch Mt. Crater. This is 6 miles roundtrip with 1300ft elevation gain which would be considered moderate by hiking standards. Please wear hiking boots, bring plenty of water, sunscreen, snacks, and a lunch. Those that do not want to do the hike could still do the meeting and easy walk to the viewpoint.
